PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- To keep global temperatures below the 1.5°C-temperature target in the Paris Agreement, urgent methane reductions across sectors will be essential to achieve immediate reductions in warming.
- The "Methane Matters Coalition" consists of five non-profit organizations [Deutsche Umwelthilfe (DUH), Changing Markets Foundation (CMF), European Environmental Bureau (EEB), Environmental Investigation Agency (EIA-UK), and Zero Waste Europe (ZWE)] working across sectors on methane reductions.
- The project's main objective is to increase ambition at European Union (EU) level and within key European countries to reduce methane by 2030, while catalyzing EU leadership in the implementation of the Global Methane Pledge (GMP).



COALITION GOALS & ANTICIPATED RESULTS

- Coalition aims to secure emission reduction targets, additional measures, enforcement of existing regulatory frameworks, and implementing the GMP.
- Reduce livestock numbers and encourage a dietary shift.
- Implement targets aimed at capping residual waste generation and reducing bio-waste in mixed waste streams.
- Implement specific mitigation measures on imported fossil fuels.
